534 cattle yarded at Grafton on Tuesday. The market for bullocks sold easier to see a top of 271c/kg. Cows however sold dearer and topped at 225c/kg. Vealers to the processor sold between 230c/kg to 255c/kg which was easier on last week. Restockers were far more selective and were willing to compete on only good quality calves.
