Numbers eased today with a combination of wet weather and a short kill week. However, a good quality run of export cattle were yarded. Most processors were operating, and a good panel of buyers were present.

Cows were slightly dearer in places but mostly sold firm. Bullocks & export heifers sold well, selling 5-8c/kg dearer on last sale. Not many feeder cattle were offered, and they remained firm. Good quality weaner cattle were scarce, however vealers ready to kill were in demand and sold up to 10c/kg dearer.
