A good yarding of export cattle was on offer with most processors operating. Heavy bulls sold well, selling 5 to 10 cents dearer. An excellent yarding of cows were on offer and the market was strong. Heavy cows sold 15 to 20 cents dearer on previous fat sales. Medium and boner type cows also lifted 10 to 20 cents. Bullocks and heavy export heifers sold well also 10 to 12 cents more. No real lines of feeder cattle to quote. Weaners were in shorter supply and quality calves were still selling well while secondary cattle were harder to sell.
