Numbers fell as well as prices today as not all processors are operating. A fair quality yarding of export cattle yarded as well as some small runs of weaner & yearling cattle. Bullocks were in short supply & only 1 processor operating, causing bullock prices to drop 30c/kg to 40c/kg cheaper. Cows were also back this week by 20c/kg on the top end & 30c/kg less across the board. Store Cows were in demand & sold firm to slightly dearer. Export Heifers followed the cow trend & sold 20-30c/kg cheaper. Not enough feeder cattle for an accurate quote. Weaner steers sold firm in the top end while lighter condition 2<sup>nd</sup> class steers received a fair deduction. Weaner heifers followed the steer trend selling well on prettier heifers. Buyers were more reluctant to buy due to the small yarding.
