Bulls sold well selling firm to dearer. Cows sold firm to dearer lifting to 15c/kg in places. Heavy bullocks and export heifers were in good supply with rises in both categories 10 to 15c/kg. Weaner cattle were in short suppl, however good quality weaners still sold firm and secondary classes of weaner cattle remained cheaper.
