Feeder cattle were in short supply however were met with strong competition and continued to climb 20 to 50 cents dearer. Good quality weaner cattle were in good supply and demand. Southern and Western NSW buyers were strong in competition. Quality weaner steers sold firm to dearer on last weeks market. Weaner heifers followed suit and remained strong.
