Numbers remained firm this week with a good quality export and weaner cattle coming forward. With most processors operating the export remained firm to dearer in places. Bulls lifted 10 to 12 cents. Heavy cows sold dearer 5 to 10 cents, medium cows and lighter condition cows sold firm to dearer 5 to 10 cents. Bullocks and heavy export heifers remain firm. Good quality lines of weaner cattle were available with better quality heifers 10 to 15 cents dearer and quality weaner steers 15 to 20 cents better. Lightweight calves were tougher to shift but remained firm on previous markets.
