Numbers flooded in for another large Fat Sale this week. Buyer attendance was good with most processors operating. A very good line up of export cattle offered, selling to a slightly easier market. Heavy bulls sold 10 to 15 cents cheaper. Heavy cows sold firm to 10-12 cents easier. Medium and lighter weight cows taking the biggest correction 15 to 20 cents. Bullocks and export heifers sold well, selling firm to 5-10 cents easier. Good quality weaner cattle continue to sell firm whilst secondary cattle followed trends selling cheaper.
