Numbers reduced this week. Quality export cattle were on offer while the weaner and yearling cattle were fairly mixed. Bullocks were in short supply selling firm to cheaper 10 to 15 cents. Heavy bulls experienced very little change selling firm. Heavy cows were in shorter supply selling firm to easier in places 10 to 12 cents. Medium weight and store cows made up the majority of the cow run selling to a similar trend 10 to 20 cents cheaper. Light weight, rougher condition weaners made up the majority of the 2nd round. Good quality steers and heifers were still fully firm to slightly dearer. Secondary weaners selling firm to cheaper 10 to 20 cents.
