A big yarding brought forward this week after some good widespread rain. Buyer attendance was good and most processors were operating. Prices were dearer across all categories this week. Heavy bulls up 10 to 12 cents, bullocks and heavy heifers sold firm to slightly dearer. Heavy cows lifted 10 to 12 cents while medium and light weight cows were up 20 to 30 cents dearer. Weaner and feeder cattle were in shorter supply however, the competition was strong and both steer and heifer categories seen large increases.
