Bullocks and heavy heifers to kill were well represented and sold fully firm on previous markets. Heavy cows were selling firm to dearer 8 to 10 cents. Medium weight and lighter condition cows sold well up to 10 to 12 cents dearer. A sprinkling of good quality weaner and feeder cattle were available selling firm to slightly easier quality related.
