Not many heavy bullocks or export heifers were yarded, however they sold firm to slightly easier. Heavy cows sold easier 10 to 15 cents while medium and light weight saw corrections of 20 to 30 cents. Feeder cattle were scarce however remained firm. Good quality weaners sold firm on previous fat sale prices, light weights and secondary cattle saw some large deductions.
