A good quality of fat cattle this week with a good panel of buyers. Most processors were operating on a dearer market all the way through after some welcome rainfall. Bulls sold firm to dearer by 10 to 12 cents. Bullocks and heavy heifers were stronger again 10 to 15 cents. Feeder cattle were in shorter supply this week but significantly dearer also. Cows were in fair supply with heavy and medium weights 15 to 20 cents stronger and store cows up to 30 to 40 cents. Weaner cattle were high demand selling anywhere from 10 cents to a dollar dearer.
