450 head of cattle yarded at Grafton today on a strong market – as trends seen around the country. Very good run of export cattle as well as good lines of early weaner calves. Heavy bulls topped at 400c/kg with a Clarence Park Angus bull going back to the paddock. Kill bulls sold to 290-300c/kg. Good run of empty heavy cows topped at 314c/kg with not all processors operating. Plain cows sold between 245-260c/kg. Small line of bullocks sold to top at 335c/kg, a 20c lift on last week. Feeder steers between 400-500kg sold to 424c/kg. Weaner Angus steers averaging 230kg sold to 468c/kg and heifers were soft today, around 250kg sold to 300c.
