

## Annual Feature Weaner Market Report

**DATE: 11.05.2026**

**TOTAL HEAD: 1191**

*Just under 1200 top quality local bred weaners were yarded for the annual feature weaner sale. The cattle presented extremely well even under the dry season leading up to it. A good panel of buyers were present including a number of interstate orders amongst good local competition. The steer sale was very strong after some much needed rainfall and more forecasted. The market was up to 60-80 cents dearer on last months sales. Steers above 250kg seemed the most sought after and european and pure angus calves attracted the most attention. Similar story on the heifer portion with feeder type heifers attracting some strong competition. Light weights were strong also with lines of cattle far stronger than singles. Euro heifers attracted the most attention with angus heifers not far behind.*
